Notes for filling out Grad Application:

1. Earned = passing final grade
Enrolled in course with potential to complete successfully by June 2010.
2. These 10 credits can come from any combination (grades 10, 11, or 12) of:
CTS (Info Pro., Foods, Mechanics), Fine Arts (Art, Band, Drama), Second Languages (French, German, Japanese), Phys Ed 20 or 30.

The same course may be reused to fulfill both requirement 2 & 3 (e.g. Band 30 / P.E. 30)

3. These ten credits can be from any 30-level course **other than English and Social** including CTS modules, option courses (P.E. 30, Band 30, Art 30), Maths and Sciences (Math 30 Applied/Pure/31, Bio/Chem/Physics 30), or Work Experience 35.

Bert Church High School requires the following:

In order to participate in the Bert Church High School Graduation Ceremony, a student must be a full-time student as per Bert Church policy (i.e. must be registered in a minimum of 30 credits). The student must be enrolled in a program that will enable him/her to graduate by June 30 of the graduating year. To determine this, **we require that students have completed 80 credits by February 1 and are enrolled in sufficient courses by March 19 of that year to graduate.** Individual Circumstances may be considered. **All School Fees must be paid in full before a student may attend the ceremonies. Students must also be in 'good standing' (ie. No suspensions or chronic absenteeism).**

Students on any Distance Education/Work Place Learning Programs are to have half of the course completed by March 19, 2010, and be passing at this time, in order to qualify for the Bert Church High School graduation list.

Students do not automatically qualify to graduate. Students must apply to take part in the graduation ceremonies. This application form must be completed and submitted to the guidance office in order for students to qualify for participation in graduation ceremonies.

We want to have a grad list posted by April 1st, so are asking students to submit this application to the Guidance Office at their earliest convenience with the deadline of **March 1, 2010.**
